Since its inception in 2008, the Ambassador Club has been Hingham Middle School's community service club for all students! The focus of the club is to help our students become more connected to our school through community service in our school, the town of Hingham, and the greater Boston area. Our annual projects include:

Coat Drive - One of our annual projects, in conjunction with the HMS PTO and a local dry cleaner, is to collect gently worn coats. These coats are then cleaned and donated to those in need throughout the Hingham and Boston area.

Care Packages for Troops - Each year the Ambassador Club sends several large care packages around the world to active U.S. military personnel. These care packages contain books, magazines, snacks, and several other difficult to find items.
