As you read, track your responses to two or three of the following grade 12 essential questions. Think about the questions in terms of characters (for fiction) or the author (for non-fiction/memoir)

1. How do individuals in these works solve or avoid problems? How does the way in which an individual responds to problems develop his/her character?
2. How do individuals in these works cope with or respond to social, political, or cultural values in their environment?
3. What prompts individuals to become an advocate for change in their environments?
4. What strong emotions are experienced by the individuals in these works and how do these emotions lead an individual to a powerful realization about him/herself or the society as a whole?
5. Do the individuals in these works experience greater internal or external conflict? Are the changes resulting from these conflicts reflected internally, externally, or both?

Each time you read, note the chapters (or pages) that you completed. As you respond, you may wish to cite pages, chapters, or sections of your book. As you respond to the essential questions, record details about events, descriptions, actions, characters, perspectives, and themes, etc. as they relate to the book in question.
